Financial aid normally is awarded for one semester (fall or spring). In unusual cases, aid may be awarded for two semesters. The awards may include a waiver of nonresident tuition. Aid recipients still must pay Missouri resident tuition, student activities, computing, recreation facility, and student health fees, as well as personal living expenses, etc.
