## Sample Ground Rules

- Everyone gets heard.
- Seek first to understand, then to be understood.
- Share "airtime."
- If you are offended or uncomfortable, say so, and say why.
- It's OK to disagree, but don't personalize it; stick to the issue.
- No name-calling or stereotyping.
- Speak for yourself, not for others.
- One person speaks at a time.
- Personal stories stay in the group, unless we <u>all</u> agree that we can share them.

## Additional Information:

- Ground rules (also known as guidelines, agreements, or covenants) help group members conduct civil, productive discussions.
- Each group sets its own ground rules at the beginning and uses them in all sessions.
- These guidelines "belong" to everyone in the group.
- Group members can modify them at any time and are expected to help enforce them.
